Cat Trees and Scratching Posts

- Posts of all sizes and textures give your cat something to safely scratch that you both can agree on
- Many products such as cardboard scratchers, scratch mats, hangable scratchers, even scratch pads that attach to corners in your home are available to help your kitty exercise his or her claws (add some catnip to make it an even better experience for your cat)
- Sisal, Tightly woven carpet, or bare wood are good choices for scratching posts and cat trees
- The post should be tall enough or your kitty to be able to do a full stretch to properly accommodate the scratching needs
- A larger cat tree is more than a scratching post to your cats. It provides a sort of kitty playground that may be pricey but will last a very long time and be an everyday part of your kitty's routine scratching.
- You can never have too many cardboard scratchers. They are inexpensive, easily replaceable, and when accompanied with some catnip will give your kitty productive and enjoyable fun time.

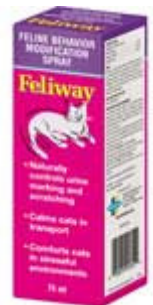


Soft Paws

- Vinyl nail covers that fit over your cats claws
- Last about 4 to 6 weeks
- Can be applied at home or by your veterinarian
- Cats get the feeling of scratching without actually puncturing any surfaces

Feliway

- Comes in a diffuser as well as a spray
- Pheromone that is said to control urine spraying, calm multicat households, reduces fighting as well as anxiety stress fear and anger, soothes ill or geriatric cats, deters scratching of furniture
